Overload Policies
 All students must have a career GPA of 3.0 or above.

Day
 Day students may take a maximum of 18 credit hours during a semester without overload approval. Overload approval may allow a Day student to take a maximum of 21 credit hrs. Each credit hour over 18 will cost an additional \$250 per hour.

- Term 3 & Term 4 Courses do not count toward total spring or fall hours for a Day student.

Online and Evening Formats
 3 courses during one term in either format are considered an overload :

- 2 classroom and 1 Internet
- 2 Internet and 1 classroom
- 3 Internet
- 3 classroom

No Online or Evening Classroom student may take more than 3 courses at any one time, even with overload approval. No Online or Evening Classroom student may take more than 27 hours in any one semester.

Evening Classes will not meet on July 4 or November 28.

* W lists the last date a grade of "W" may be assigned.
 After that date, a grade of "WP" or "WF" should be assigned.

** The 60% date indicates that a student must attend **past** that date to fulfill Financial Aid requirements. If a student withdraws from a class before the 60% date specified for a particular term, the student is responsible for some/all monies due to Limestone College for that class. **
